Entries to be sent by Email or Post only (Email preferred). Entries sent by email to any other Email Address other than that stated on this schedule will not be accepted. It is your responsibility to ensure that your entry is sent to the correct Email Address.

DEFINITIONS **OPEN** – Unrestricted but dogs must be of an Open Test standard
NOVICE – Dogs not to have been placed 1st in a Novice Working Test, placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in an Open Working Test, or ANY Field Trial Award.
PUPPY – Dogs must be **under** the age of 18 months on the day of the Test.
