DEFINITIONS	OPEN – Unrestricted but dogs must be of an Open Test standard NOVICE – Dogs not to have been placed 1 st in a Novice Working Test, placed 1 st , 2 nd or 3 rd in an Open Working Test, or ANY Field Trial Award.

All dogs must be registered with The Kennel Club. Bitches in season or just coming out of season will not be allowed onto the ground. Anyone knowing their dogs have been in contact with any infectious disease should not attend the test.
