DEFINITIONS:	NOVICE – Confined to dogs which have not gained a place or certificate of merit at a Field Trial, been placed first, second or third in an Open GWT or first in a Novice GWT held in accordance with Kennel Club Rules and Field Trial Regulations. NOVICE DOG / NOVICE HANDLER – Handler and dog to have not received a 1 st in a NDNH, been placed including COM in a Novice, all aged or open working test. PUPPY 6-12 months – confined to dogs between 6-12 months of age on the date of the test. PUPPY 12- 18 months – Confined to dogs between 12- 18 months of age on the date of the test.
GENERAL:	All dogs must be registered with the Kennel Club. Bitches in season will not be allowed on the ground. Anyone knowing their dogs have been in contact with any infectious disease should not attend the Test.

Your dog is at risk if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.
